Description

Massive bronze tripod censor; mottled gold flecked surface; 2 rounded handles; intaglio Ming Hsuan-te mark (1426-35); possibly of the period. Wooden cover

with ivory finial, late 19th century. The compressed body flanked by a pair of loop handles with attractive mottled golden-brown tone. The interior with an inscription on adhered paper describing the censer. The base cast with an apocryphal Xuande seal mark. Raised on a fitted wood stand carved with the three auspicious fruits, and with a lotus-leaf form cover.
