



## Saint Francis in Ecstasy

### Description

St. Francis is presented in three-quarter length, arms raised in an attitude of prayer, his face depicts the typology of adoration and ecstasy, and he holds a large bronze cross in the crook of his left arm. At the lower right corner are other symbols associated with the saint: the open book and the skull (mortality). He also displays the marks of the stigmata on his raised hands.
