Tule, leather, and pigment

# Description

Weave: Twined with full-twist overlay. Male figure made of same materials and technique as Klamath baskets. Starts at top of head, has added warp for arms and ends in miniature rawhide moccasins on feet. Hair on head and trousers are dark (mud-dyed tule) weft; two bands around chest are checkerboard of alternate plain and dark weft. Areas of flesh are light brown dyed weft; facial features are embroidered on surface. Narrow leather band around head with small feather.

### **Dimensions**

Object:  $7 \frac{1}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times 2$ " ( $18.4 \times 7.9 \times 5.1$  cm)
