Vessel in the shape of a fang-chueh; grey green color with a few areas of beige; heavily pierced flanges articulating edges form and dividing body into zones; Tao-t'ieh and other archaic decoration in the Shang style. Of square form and raised on four splayed and tapering legs, carved

on the body with archaistic taotie masks and scrolls interspersed with vertical bands of raised flanges. One side issuing a handle from the mouth of a beast and the other side with a spout and two raised finials.
