

# Basic Detail Report

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## Dress

### Primary Maker

### Medium

Hide, beads, and jingles

### Description

Three hides, sinew sewn; one forms the skirt front, one the back, one the bodice which is slit for neck opening and sewn at the waist to the two bottom skins. Sides of the bodice are open and fringed. Beaded yoke, blue with dark blue, yellow and green triangle and cross designs executed in lazy-stitch. Leg tabs on each side and a fine

fringe attached around hem; two beaded rows around hem. Leg tabs decorated with tin jingles and three rows of light blue beading.
